



Shoally Creek Elementary SIC
Meeting Minutes
Thursday, November 16, 2017
School Media Center

SIC Officers/Members Present: Diane Threlkeld, Allison Hansen, Darryl Kosiorek, Laura Szynalski, and Laura Meyer

Mrs. Meyer called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm.

Principal Laura Meyer welcomed all members and introduced Darryl Kosiorek, who was not present at the last meeting.

Principal Meyer shared the minutes from the meeting on Thursday, October 26, 2017. A motion was made by Darryl Kosiorek to approve the minutes. No discussion took place. A second motion was made and the council voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the last SIC meeting.

At the last SIC meeting, the council had decided to table the selection of the position of secretary until the November meeting. It was decided at the current meeting to postpone the selection of the position of secretary until the January meeting. Principal Meyer stated that she would reach out to the next highest voted parent to inquire about SIC membership as well as filling the position of secretary.

Principal Meyer reviewed the Shoally Creek Report Card Narrative with the council. The Report Card Narrative is located on the State Department website and provides stakeholders with information about SCE. Principal Meyer shared the process for developing the narrative. After the council reviewed the narrative, Principal Meyer explained the 2017 Shoally Creek Elementary School Report Card data. The council studied the 2017 SC Ready/SCPASS test scores and asked questions regarding the data. Principal Meyer also shared insight into the results of the surveys, which were completed by teachers, students, and parents. She stressed with the council that the test data and survey results are very important because they serve as the baseline data for our new school. Principal Meyer shared the strengths and challenges of our progress during the first year of Shoally Creek Elementary.

Allison Hansen shared that Mr. Jeremy Byrd has been more consistent with the morning and afternoon traffic duty. She also shared that she contacted Sean Knight, who is involved in conducting traffic studies in South Carolina. He has adjusted the stop light at Shoally Creek Road and Parris Bridge Road and it is now staying green for 30 seconds longer between 7:00 am and 8:00 am, as well as 2:00 pm and 3:00 pm. Mr. Knight is also looking into studying the stop light at Highway 9 and Shoally Creek Road.

Mrs. Hansen informed the council that state troopers are monitoring the speed along Parris Bridge Road.

Allison Hansen announced that volunteers are needed for the Santa Supper on December 14th. Individuals who volunteer must have a SLED check. Principal Meyer stated that she will announce to the faculty/staff that comp time will be offered for those who volunteer.

The SIC's next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, January 18, 2018 from 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm in the Media Center.

The meeting was adjourned by Mrs. Meyer at 4:00 pm.
